Find your flattering red lipstick!

◆ Fair skin? Your best red: Cherry!

"Classic cherry reds have just a touch of bluish pink in them," says Camal. "That cool undertone flatters your pale skin tone!"

◆ Medium or olive skin? Your best red: Brick!

"This soft red has gold and brown in it that complement the natural warmth in your skin tone," says Camal.

◆ Dark skin? Your best red: Wine!

"Women with darker skin usually have darker lips," says Camal. "And a deep wine has enough pigment in it to give your lips a rich color."

Our picks: 1. Black Radiance Perfect Tone Lip Color in Eldorado Red, \$1.99. 2. Almay Ideal Lip Liner in Wine, \$7.49. 3. Tropez Ultra Glaze Lip Gloss in Passion Plum, \$2.



The best way to apply red lipstick!

- 1 With a red lip liner, precisely line your lips right at the edges. Then lightly feather in the color on the inside of your lips.
- 2 Smudge the inside color with your fingertip.

- 3 Use a lip brush to carefully apply the first coat of red lipstick.
- 4 Blot with a tissue, then apply a second coat of red with the lip brush.

"This gives you a rich red color that won't bleed at the edges and has a lot of staying power," says Camal. Looking for a sheener texture? "Skip the second coat of lipstick or simply opt for a coat of red gloss!"
